Job Purpose: Welland Operations Limited (WOL) are an Operation and Maintenance (O&M) service provider who have been awarded a 5-year agreement to operate and maintain Welland Biomass Facility, located at, Pebble Hall, Off Theddingworth Road, Theddingworth, Leicestershire, LE17 6NJ. The Facility uses gasification technology and is designed to process up to 72,000 tonnes of Biomass per annum. WOL is a wholly owned subsidiary of Cobalt Energy Operational Services Limited (CEOSL) who are part of the Cobalt Energy Group along with Cobalt Energy Ltd (CEL). Responsibilities

- Operate the Front Loading Shovel to ensure stock levels are maintained at the required level

- Change and empty skips/dust bags
- Assist in clearing blockages within the system
- Support the facility maintenance team
- Liaise with fuel supplier
- Operate forklift truck
- Working within the Company H&S, Environmental policies, and Standard Operating Procedures.
- Maintain a high standard of housekeeping on the plant at all times
- Complete daily shift reports and handover to the next shift
- Re-fuelling of site vehicles
- To work as part of 365 day 24/7 shift rota
