Job Purpose:

Working on a 2-day, 2-night, 4 off shift pattern to ensure safe vehicle movements and manoeuvring, whilst managing and maintaining the biomass fuel levels within the fuel hall. Keeping all areas clean and tidy (including the fuel yard and weighbridge).

Role and Responsibilities:

- Working to company H&S and environmental policy
- Pre-shift checks and sheets must be completed and recorded (any defects reported to the Shift Team Leader)
- Daily maintenance (greasing and cleaning)
- Report any breaches/near misses immediately to the site management team
- The safe operation of mobile plant
- Emptying Tip Skips / Dust Bags
- Maintain a high standard of housekeeping on the plant at all times
- Shift Handover to next Loading Shovel Driver
- Take and record fuel samples
- Re-Fuelling of site vehicles

Key Accountabilities:

- Reporting defects to line manager
- Damages (Caused while operating - not defects)

Systems & Processes:

- Waste Wood is gasified and combusted to make superheated steam to drive a steam turbine and produce electricity exported to the grid

- Experience driving a loading shovel essential (Ideally CPCS, NPORS or similar)
- Counterbalance forklift & Telehandler experience desirable
- Able to load and unload HGV vehicles desirable but not essential
